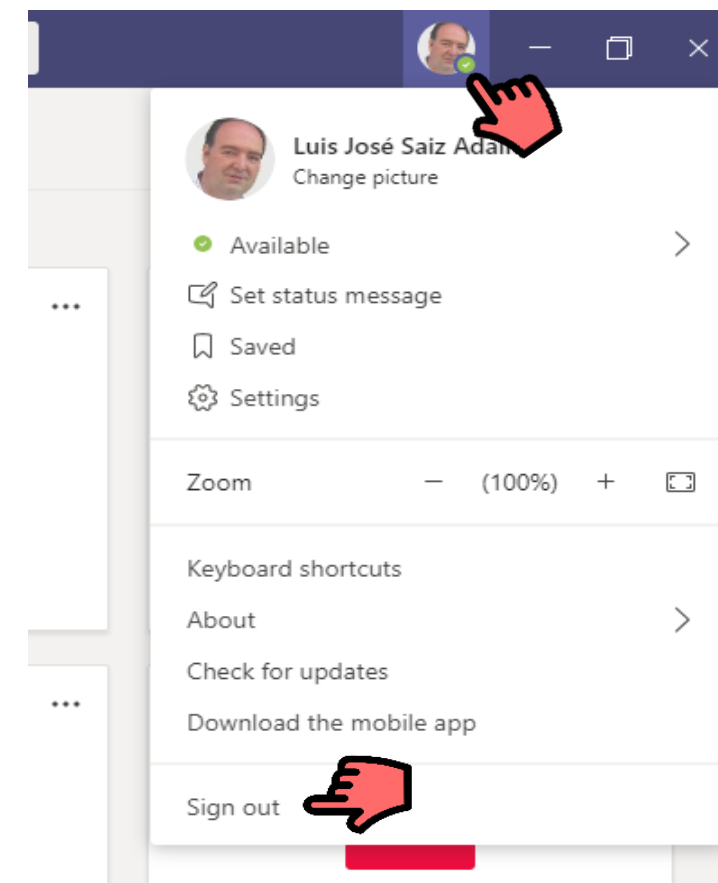
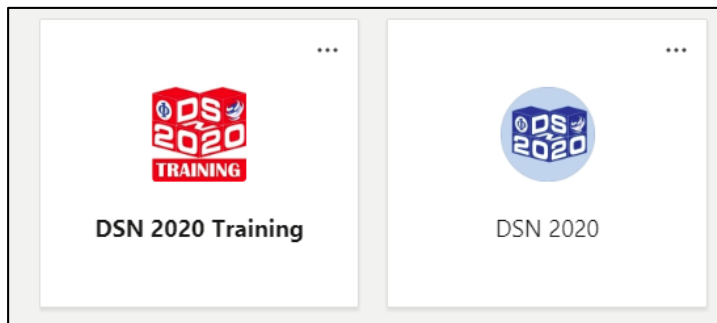
DSN 2020

Teams and Channels

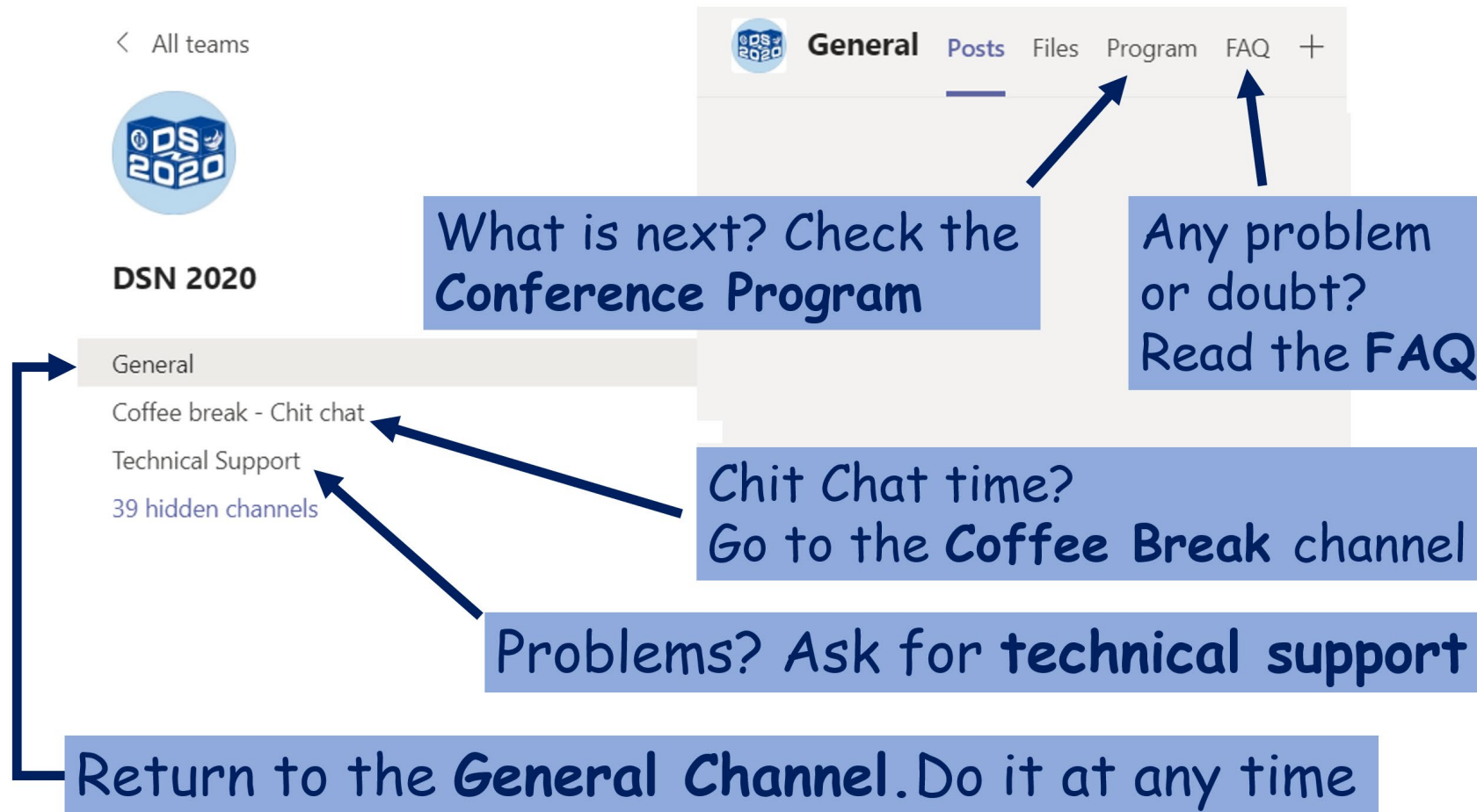
- **Team:** group of users
- *Channel:* subset of a team (could be all users) talking about a matter
- All attendees belong to the **DSN 2020** team. Within this team, you can observe, at least, three communication channels:
 - *General:* read only; employed by the organization to distribute important info
 - *Coffee Break – Chit chat:* informal chat
 - *Technical Support:* ask for technical help

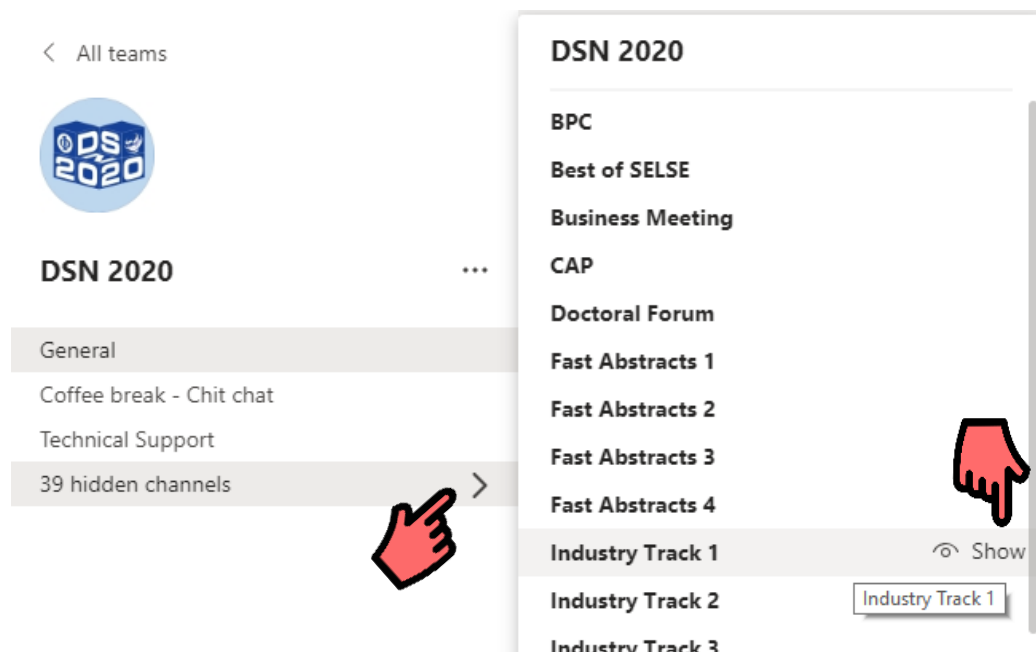




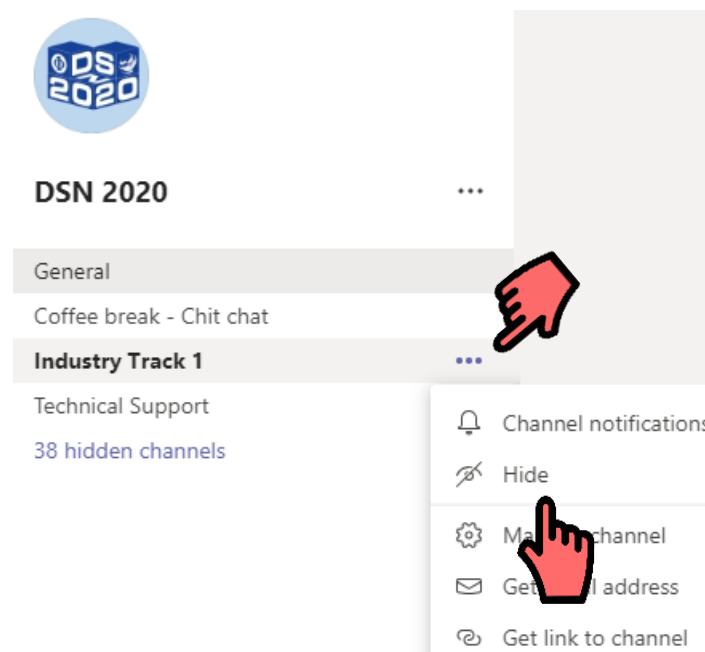
Channels

How to show a channel



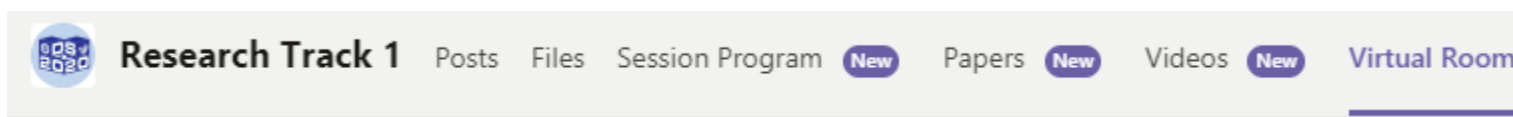
How to hide a channel
